Categories:

Limb Loss Community Award

An individual or team having made a significant contribution or difference to the limb loss community.

Limb Loss Professional Award

An individual or team working within the limb loss sector having made a significant contribution or difference in supporting lives beyond limb loss.

LA Member Award

An LA member/volunteer/team that has made a significant contribution to supporting lives beyond limb loss through their achievements, volunteering or work.

Young Achiever Award (30 years and under)

We want to recognise the achievements of young amputees and limb impaired young people of which we know there are many – whether through their personal, professional, volunteering or sporting achievements.

Lifetime Achievement Award

There are many individuals who have devoted their lives and careers to champion developments, improvements and change for the benefit of the wider limb loss community – we want to recognise their dedication.

Terms and Conditions

1. The awards are open to LA members, volunteers, patients and professionals from across the limb loss sector from within the UK.
2. Nominations can be made by a LA members, amputees and professionals from across the limb loss sector from within the UK. The organiser reserves the right to reject any entrant that is deemed inappropriate.
3. Entries must be made by completing the LA's awards nomination form.
4. All nominations must be received by 5pm Monday 23rd October 2018.
5. The judging panel comprising a minimum of 6 will be made up of our event and award sponsors, our keynote speakers and an LA representative (Trustee – 1 vote).
6. Judging will take place week commencing 23rd October.
7. Winning entries will be those which, in the opinion and sole discretion of the panel of judges, best meet the judging criteria.
8. Any judge, with any personal interest or in any way related to a category will declare an interest and will not be able to cast a vote for that category.
9. The judges' decisions shall be final and binding in all respects on all entrants. no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Winners will be announced and receive their trophy at the awards ceremony. There will be no prior disclosure. Shortlisted nominees will be notified in advance. Winners who are not present at the ceremony will be contacted to arrange collection or delivery of their trophy after the event.
11. Finalists will be announced by 26th October 2018.
12. If the awards ceremony is abandoned, cancelled or suspended in whole or in part by reason or cause not within the control of the organisers the organisers shall be under no obligation to compensate participants in any way with associated costs (e.g. hotel accommodation, pre-paid travel expenses etc). The organisers reserve the right to change the venue and/or timing of the awards ceremony or the awards format at any time.
